



ONE-TO-ONE MENTORING

2,047 YOUTH IN 2019-2020

Starting in March 2020, all matches met and engaged in workshops virtually, keeping connected while maintaining a safe distance in light of COVID-19.

GROUP ENGAGEMENT & MENTORING

154 YOUTH IN 2019-2020

At-risk youth (Littles) are strategically matched with a mentor (Big), who provides coaching, guidance and support.

COMMUNITY-BASED: Bigs and Littles explore the local community together, sharing activities they both enjoy.

SCHOOL TO WORK: Bigs and Littles engage in college and career readiness workshops and job shadowing at the Big's place of work.

BIGS IN SCHOOLS/SITES: Bigs and Littles spend time together at the Little's school or after-school program.

BIGS IN BLUE: Local police officers serve as Bigs through any one of the one-toone mentoring programs.

Littles engage in programs that prepare them for post-secondary success, both while in high school and upon graduation. Programs include college success coaching through Take Stock in Children, a Graduate Program that provides ongoing mentorship match support to alumni Littles and the Bigs, college and career readiness workshops, and a scholarship program that awards funding to Littles continuing their education.

Youth waiting to be matched with a Big, along with those already matched, engage in enrichment activities that have impact(s) in one or more of five key areas, known as the BIG5 – Academic Enrichment, Career Pathways, Digital Literacy, Health & Wellness, and Music & the Arts.
